AREA FACTS

Charleston delivers small-town charm in spades, from the shady courtyards and old Victorian homes to the horse-drawn carriages and six gorgeous beaches. But while the classic southern backdrop is a huge draw, this coastal stunner has plenty of big city attractions.

Go ahead and do the historic sites—Middleton Place, Fort Sumter National Museum, the French Quarter, to name a worthy few—but work in time for checking out the city's contemporary side. There's the International African American Museum, 30-plus art galleries, and a dynamic, ever-evolving food scene, serving everything from Lowcountry staples to modern tapas.

The Charleston Place's central location provides access to explore the wonderful culture, art, dining, and shopping that Charleston has to offer. It is also located within close distance to many of the best restaurants the city has to offer.

FLIGHT ARRANGEMENTS

The Charleston International Airport is located approximately 12 miles from the Charleston Place and offers direct flights from most major cities and all major airlines. The airport offers flights with American, Delta, JetBlue, Southwest, United, as well as other smaller airlines. From the airport, it is recommended you take a taxi or Uber/Lyft to the Hotel. GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Taxi/Uber/Lyft – all are permitted to pick up and drop off customers at the Charleston International Airport.

Once you request your ride you will exit out of the baggage claim area and follow signs to the covered shelter which is across both roadways and to the right of the last sidewalk.



HELPFUL INFORMATION

Time Zone - Charleston is in the Eastern Daylight Time Zone.

Climate – The daytime temperatures in June average around 80-85° F and evenings average around 75° F.

*ABE/ALIP DIRECTORS TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT POLICY

Airfare – Your flight must be booked more than 2 weeks prior to departure with a non-refundable ticket. Tickets purchased within 2 weeks of departure will be reimbursed only up to the amount the ticket would have cost had it been purchased more than 2 weeks in advance.

Car Rental and Hotel Parking – If you elect to rent a car, car rental, gas and hotel parking expenses will only be reimbursed up to the amount of the taxi or Uber/Lyft for each board member (\$70 per board member, which is the approximate round trip fare inclusive of gratuity from the Charleston International Airport to The Charleston Place). NO additional expenses relating to the rental of a car will be reimbursed for this meeting. The hotel charges \$53 per night for valet parking which comes with in and out privileges. There is also selfpark across the street for \$2/hour. This will not be a reimbursable expense for this meeting.
