Flight Arrangements

LaGuardia Airport is located approximately 7.5 miles from the Royalton and offers connecting flights from most major cities and all major airlines. The airport offers flights with American, Delta, Southwest, United Airlines and more. From the airport, it is recommended you take a taxi or Uber/Lyft to the Hotel. <u>Ground Transportation</u> Taxis

Currently, passengers are able to pick up licensed New York City taxis in front of Terminal A, B, and C in dedicated pick-up areas. Please follow terminal wayfinding signage or speak to an Airport Customer Experience Specialist to locate the taxi pick-up area at your terminal.

Uber/Lyft

...If You're Arriving at Terminal A

The passenger pick-up area for Car Services and App-based Rides is located directly outside of, and across the street from, Terminal A.

... If You're Arriving at Terminal B

The Car Service and App-Based Ride pick-up area is located on Level 2 of the Terminal B Parking Garage, located directly adjacent to Terminal B.

...If You're Arriving at Terminal C

The Car Service and App-Based Ride pick-up areas are located at Terminal C arrivals (ground) level. Terminal C pick-up is at the arrival's inner lane.

<u>ABE/ALIP Directors Travel Reimbursement Policy</u> Airfare

Your flight must be booked more than 2 weeks prior to departure with a non-refundable ticket. Tickets purchased within 2 weeks of departure will be reimbursed only up to the amount the ticket would have cost had it been purchased more than 2 weeks in advance.

Car Rental and Hotel Parking

If you elect to rent a car, car rental, gas and hotel parking expenses will only be reimbursed up to the amount of the taxi or Uber/Lyft for each board member (\$140 per board member which is the approximate round trip fare inclusive of gratuity from). No additional expenses relating to the rental of a car will be reimbursed for this meeting. The hotel charges \$75 a night for sedans and \$85 for SUVs for valet parking. This will not be a reimbursable expense for this meeting.
