AREA FACTS

Dana Point is named after Richard Henry Dana (1815-1882), a sailor and author famous for his novel, *Two Years Before the Mast*. In it, he refers to Dana Point as "the only romantic spot in California."

Dana Point had an international impact as one of the birthplaces of surf culture. Local surfing enthusiasts in the 1950s flocked to the area to test their luck on the legendary surf break, Killer Dana. Though the construction of Dana Point Harbor in 1966 disbanded Killer Dana's waves, the town's surfing heritage lives on through its cultural contributions.

Incorporated in 1989, and currently home to over 35,000 residents, this beautiful coastal city has over seven miles of prominent coastal bluffs and rolling hills. It Offers numerous annual festivals and many attractions such as the Orange County Marine Institute with the famous Tallship Pilgrim docked next door, Dana Point Harbor with its two marinas and 2,500 boats, and Doheny State Beach, a surfing haven with a beachfront campground.

FLIGHT ARRANGEMENTS

The John Wayne Airport-Orange County is located approximately 22 miles from the Ritz-Carlton, Laguna Niguel in Dana Point, CA and offers direct flights from some major cities and most major airlines. From any airport, it is recommended that you take a taxi or Uber/Lyft to the Hotel. If you choose to rent a car, please note that overnight valet parking at the Ritz-Carlton is \$70/day. Self-parking is not available.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Taxi/Uber/Lyft – all are permitted to pick up and drop off customers at all three airports.

John Wayne Airport – All pickups occur at the designated areas located on the top levels of parking structures A2 and B2, and in the Terminal C parking structure on the upper level next to the ticketing area.

Los Angeles International Airport – LAX-it (pronounced LA Exit) is the new way to get to your Taxi, or ride app services (Uber, Lyft, or Opoli). Walk or catch the free shuttle outside baggage claim on level one to LAX-it.

San Diego International Airport – All pickups occur at the designated areas located on the ground level directly across from the terminal.

Drop offs at all 3 airports occur in the regular departure areas.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

Time Zone – Dana Point is in the Pacific Daylight Time Zone.

Climate – The daytime temperatures in November average around 67-76° F and evenings average around 57° F.

Nautical Casual Attire

Men – khaki slacks, jeans and polo shirt, sneakers, loafers or boat shoes, light jacket or sweater

Women – sundress, skirt, jeans, shirt/blouse, sneakers, boat shoes, sandals or low heeled or flat shoes, light sweater or jacket
